



New Classroom Building Approved by Bishop Olmsted

We are pleased to announce that Bishop Olmsted has recently approved the construction of our new classroom building! Seton Catholic Preparatory faces a very exciting future and is committed to continuing its legacy of quality Catholic education by expanding to meet the academic needs of the community. In response to this unprecedented demand for quality Catholic education, Seton developed a multi-year, phased Master Plan. The goal of the Master Plan is to establish the framework for campus expansion including increased space for:

- Advanced Placement and honors courses
- technology resources, libraries and laboratories
- fine arts classes and programs
- athletic facilities and programs
- campus support for administration, clubs, meetings and events

The approval of this new classroom building is the second major building approved as part of our campus expansion Master Plan. The new St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Chapel serves as the center of our new campus. The new classroom building will be a three-story, 55,000 sq. ft. classroom building and will be built to the west of the chapel. The classroom building will provide a much needed new fine arts level, a black box theater with seating for 400 and 16 additional classrooms, allowing the school to increase its enrollment to 700 students. Construction of the shell of the building will begin in early 2010 with interior completion to follow. We need your continued support to complete the funding of our new classroom.
